At Lucid Motors, safety is always the top priority. We urge our customers to prioritize safety and seek out authorized service providers for any necessary repairs or replacements of structural components.

The design of the Lucid Air and Gravity Body in White consists of three different material configurations:

- Stampings
- Extrusions
- High Pressure Die Castings (HPDC)

The unique design and integration of the three materials ensure safety and performance. HPDC components provide structural integrity and support for the vehicle's underbody. Non-replaceable casting components are critical to the overall structural integrity of our products. This approach also ensures that our customers will be provided with high-quality service and support.

Some casting components cannot be repaired after a collision repair. The following cast components are not replaceable and are not available to purchase.

 **Note:** Items marked as non-replaceable are not available for purchase as repair parts.

The five non-replaceable components where HPDC is used are:

- Front Torque Boxes (one per side)
- Rear Torque Boxes (one per side)
- Mid Floor Crossmember Casting

*The components listed above are shown in the image to the right in red **are non-replaceable**.

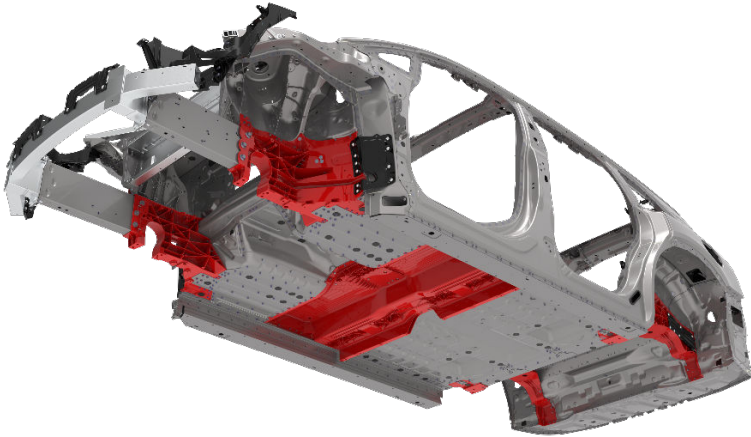
